Local Residents

Summary of engagement with Local Residents

The National Paediatric Hospital Development Board is mindful of our neighbours and there has been extensive consultation with local residents during the design process of the new children's hospital. Throughout the engagement process we have listened to their concerns and adapted and amended plans for the new children's hospital where possible.




The NPHDB commenced a series of 'drop in' information sessions for residents living within the vicinity of the St. James's Campus. Leaflets informing residents about these sessions were distributed to over 4000 homes, counsellors and TD's and resident associations were also informed. The 'drop in' sessions were held in a local community hall, the F2 Centre in Dublin 8 from 4pm until 8pm. Lots of feedback was garnered and residents were given an opportunity fill out a feedback form and provided with a contact email to express their views.







The new children's hospital wants to be a good neighbour and as a direct result of ongoing engagement the most notable actions were taken:





- The level of the road carrying double-deckers was lowered
- Trees will be planted to improve privacy for houses overlooked by the hospital.
- Planning for the parent's accommodation is being submitted at the same time as nch, this was a direct request from residents.
- Examination of the screening options for balconies facing onto South Circular Road
- A vibration monitor will be placed in local homes to detect any structural changes, which will then be used to ensure that any possible damage is repaired, and a condition survey has been offered to residents living in close proximity to the new children's hospital.
- Congestion worries will be addressed by ensuring construction workers park at the Red Cow and use the Luas to travel to work
- Construction vehicles will not be allowed park in the area, but will be kept at a holding zone on Davitt Road and called to the site on a 'just in time' basis.



Summary of engagement with Hospital Staff – Clinical and Non-clinical

Activity and Capacity: The Hospital Design Coordinators arranged a series of Activity and Capacity Planning workshops delivered by The Health Planners. Clinical Leads, Chief Operation Officers, Directors of Nursing and Senior Managers were invited to attend. These meetings were used as information tools to ascertain hospital activities which in turn were used to inform the activity for the new children's hospital. Follow up meetings were scheduled with individual clinical specialities to review their specific activity data.

Standard Room Process: Agreeing the design layout of the standard rooms in the hospital at this stage help to determine the layout of large floor areas in the hospital. The standard room process for the chosen departments were carried out over 3 meetings. These meetings looked at the functionality of the room, what the room will consist of and all the equipment required to support the activity for that particular room.

The **Hospital Design Working Group** is made up of clinical leads, nursing and support service representatives from the three hospitals. There is also representation from the Children's Hospital Group Management teams and the National Paediatric Hospital Development Board Project team. The role of this group is to give expert advice and guidance from a whole hospital perspective on issues coming from the user group consultation process.

Regional Visits: A series of regional information sessions have taken place: Limerick Regional Hospital and Galway University hospital and Cork University Hospital. 



